



Biography Jan van Duikeren's Fingerprint

Fingerprint is a Dutch all-star collective led by trumpeter Jan van Duikeren. With its roots in nu-jazz, funk, soul and gospel, the quintet create the 'fingerprint' which showcases van Duikeren's musical vision, infusing drive and skill to both their live sets and recent recordings. By sharing their respective inspirations the band members operate as a collective, thus creating a like-minded musical hub.

Jan van Duikeren is one of the most sought-after and internationally acclaimed trumpet soloists in the Netherlands and his collaborations have included such diverse names as Candy Dulfer, Lonnie Smith, Joe Jackson, Diana Ross, Paul Weller and many others. None other than Quincy Jones praised the musical abilities of the multiple award-winning van Duikeren.

Equally at home in the recording studio and on jazz stages, Fingerprint are carrying on a tradition unique in the jazz world - bringing together players who can meld their talents into a vision much larger than the sum of its parts. The band, indeed, produce an identifiable fingerprint.
